Expenditures:- Lighting \$865.00, Water 1000.00, Police 1320.00, Clerk 120.00, Treasurer 120.00, Attorney 600.00, Printing 45.00, Industrial Ins. 75.00, Elections 50.00, Town Hall 250.00, Fire Insurance 80.00, Police Expense 50.00, Cleaning Streets and Sewer 205.00, Auditing 45.00, Bonds 40.00, Fire Department 140.00, Library 220.00, Streets 935.00, Parks 165.00, Total Expense \$5805.00

Receipts - Prof. Card License \$100.00, Draft 100.00, Show & Dance 25.00, Hall Rent 50.00, Interest 100.00, State Liquor 455.00, State Highway 935.00, Extra Revenue 800.00, 15 mill ~~income~~ tax on Town valuation of \$2,160,070.00 \$3240.00, Total Receipts \$5805.00

Leaving the amount of \$3240.00 to be raised by direct taxation of property within the Town.

On motion duly made and recorded the above budget as outlined by the Finance Committee was unanimously adopted.
