

Rosalie, Wash., Oct 5, 1936.

The Town Council of the Town of Rosalie met in special session on this date, as per requirements of the state law, for the purpose of hearing any taxpayer in favor or against the proposed expenditures of public funds; as set forth in the annual budget.

Present - Mayor L. B. Brockway; Councilmen Higgs, Tausch, Myers and Brown, Absent - Swedin.

No objections were made to the Budget as advertised, as the taxpayer, and it was moved and seconded that the Budget for the year 1937 be accepted, and that the sum of \$3240⁰⁰ be made the amount to be raised by direct taxation of property within the Town. The vote being unanimous the Budget was declared legally adopted by the Mayor.
