

Rosalie, Wash. October 13, 1936

Town Council met in regular session on this date

Present. Mayor L. Brockway; Councilmen Knight, Myers and Brown. Absent Higgins and Swedin.

Minutes of regular meeting held Sept. 8<sup>th</sup> and special meeting held Oct. 5, were read and approved.

Communication from the City of Cheney inviting the Town officials of the Town of Rosalie to the second annual Regional meeting of the Assoc. of Washington Cities to be held in their city October 20<sup>th</sup>, 1936, was read.

Moved and seconded that the resolution outlined by the State Highway Department authorizing the State Auditor to transfer to the State Highway Dept. \$28<sup>57</sup>, the cost of center striping the primary highway within the town limits of Rosalie be accepted. Carried unanimously.

Permission was granted Rosalie Producers, Inc. to construct a garage on the southwest corner of office lots.

Rosalie Producers, Inc. application for permission to use for loading, construction, or otherwise within Town ordinances, that part of Railroad Ave. unused by the N.P. Ry Co. the width of Fourth St. adjoining the N.P. Ry right of way, and adjoining the end of Fourth St. Also the width of Fourth St. running 40 feet East from its junction with Railroad Ave. was referred to the Street and Alley Committee
