

Rosalie, Wash. June 8, 1937

Town Council met in regular session on this date.

Present Mayor H. Higgs; Councilmen Brown, Helmer and Blackman. Absent Sweden.

Minutes of last regular session read and approved.

Mayor Higgs presented the name of Dr. E. L. Ogden to fill the vacancy of Councilman caused by his (Higgs) advancement to Mayor. On motion duly made and seconded, the appointment was unanimously confirmed.

Dr. E. L. Ogden subscribed to the Oath of Office as Councilman.

Russell Swin was present and asked what disposition the Council cared to make of the cabin in the Tourist Park. Referred to the Park Committee.

Moved and seconded that the Resolution authorizing the State Auditor to transfer to the state Highway Department \$35⁰⁰ to pay the cost of center striping the primary highway within the Town limits of Rosalie, and the purchase of 5 gallons of paint, be adopted unanimously.

Moved and seconded that Resolution authorizing the State Auditor to transfer to the State Highway Department \$150⁰⁰ to improve shoulders along the primary highway within the Town limits of Rosalie as requested by the Street Committee be accepted. Passed unanimously.

Moved and seconded that the ~~Street Com.~~ Light Committee be instructed to meet with the Washington Water Power Co. and arrange to install street lights where found necessary. Carried unanimously.

Communication from the Rosalie Branch, Old Natl. Bank and Union Trust Co. stating that beginning July 1, 1937, the rate of interest paid on open accounts will be reduced to 1/2 of 8 per cent per annum was read.
