

Rosalia, Wash. Aug 24, 1937

Town Council met in regular session on this date.

Present Mayor. St. Higgins; Councilmen Swedin, Helmer and Blackman. Absent Brown and Ogden.

Minutes of last regular session read and approved.

Moved and seconded that the Community Club be permitted to hold a Carnival and Harvest Festival on Sept. 17 and 18 and that a rental charge of \$40.00 for use of grounds and streets be made. The Community Club agreeing to clean up all rubbish, etc. or paying expense of having it done.

This being the date fixed by law for making up the annual budget, estimate of money required to defray the Town expenses for the ensuing year was made as follows:-

Expenditures:- Lighting 935.00, Water 1000.00, Police 1320.00, Clerk 120.00, Treasurer 120.00, Attorney 40.00, Printing 65.00, Ind. Sec. & Med. Aid 240.00, Elections 50.00, Fire Insurance 30.00, Town Hall 150.00, Police Expense 20.00, Streets 1260.00, Auditing 50.00, Bonds 40.00, Fire Department 190.00, Library 220.00, Parks 50.00, Total Expense 5990.00.

Receipts:- Palana Card License 100.00, May License 105.00, Show and Dance License 25.00, Hall Rent 50.00, State Liquor 455.99, State Highway 1260.00, Extra Revenue 600.00, 15 mill Tax on Town valuation of \$226,035.00 - 3305.00, Total Receipts 5990.00.

Leaving the amount of \$3305.00 to be raised by direct taxation of property within the Town

One motion duly made and seconded the above budget as outlined by the Finance Committee was unanimously adopted.

Monday, October 4, 1937, at 8 P.M. the Town Council will meet for the purpose of hearing any taxpayer in favor of or against the expenditures of public funds as above stated, and the Clerk was instructed to so advertise.
