Moved and seconded that the Fire Committee be instructed to purchase fire equipment from the Howard-Croper Corporation at their bid price of \$3118⁷³, and extra equipment as follows:- 150 gallon tank, \$25⁰⁰, 150 feet $\frac{3}{4}$ in. hose coupled \$69³⁰; one $\frac{3}{4}$ inch nozzle, \$14⁰⁰; one searchlight, \$39⁰⁰; two rear spot lights \$37⁰⁰; total \$3302²⁰, less 5% or \$130⁰⁰, net price \$3172²⁰. Also two hand extinguishers to be included. One Sterling Jr. 20 siren to be furnished without charge. Carried unanimously.

Moved and seconded that bids be asked for three and five horse power fire sirens. Carried unanimously.
