

Rosalia, Wash. Aug 23, 1938

Town Council met in regular session on this date.

Present - Mayor H. Higgo - Councilmen Helmer, Swedin, Blackman and Martin. Absent Brown.

Minutes of last regular session read and approved.

This being the date fixed by law for making up the annual budget, estimates of money required to defray the Town expenses for the ensuing year was made as follows:

Expenditures - Lighting 500° , Water 1000° , Police 1520° , Clerk 120° , Treasurer 120° , Attorney 60° , Printing 75° , Ind. Ins. & Med Aid. 180° , Elections 50° , City Hall 130° , Fire Insurance 30° , Police Expense 20° , Streets 1260° , Streets & Alley 100° , Auditing 50° , Bonds 40° , Fire Department 220° , Library 220° , Parks 75° . Total Expenses $\$6010^{\circ}$

Receipts: - Pool Card License 70° , Day License 75° , Show & Dance License 14° , City Hall Rent 50° , State Liquor 550° , State Highway Dept. 1260° , Extra Revenue 540° , 15 mill tax on Town valuation of $\$230069^{\circ}$ - $\$3451^{\circ}$. Total Receipts $\$6010^{\circ}$

Leaving the amount of $\$3451^{\circ}$ to be raised by direct taxation of property within the Town.

On motion duly made and recorded the ab budget as above outlined by the Finance Committee was unanimously adopted.

Monday, October 3, 1938, at 8 P.M., the Town Council will meet for the purpose of hearing any taxpayer in favor of or against the expenditures of public funds as stated above, and the Clerk was instructed to so advertise.
