

Rosalie, Wash. Oct. 3, 1938

The Town Council of the Town of Rosalia met in special session on this date as per requirement of the State law, for the purpose of hearing any tax-payers in favor of or against the proposed expenditures of public funds, as set forth in the annual budget.

Present - Mayor H. Higgs - Councilmen - Brown, Swedin and Martin. Absent - Helmer and Blackman

No objections were made to the Budget as advertised by the taxpayers, and it was moved and seconded that the Budget for the year 1939 be accepted, and that the sum of \$3451⁰⁰ be made the amount to be raised by direct taxation of the property within the Town. The vote being unanimous, the Budget was declared legally adopted by the Mayor.
