Moved and seconded that the Resolution handed in by J. A. Masterson, Highway Engineer, authorizing the State Auditor to transfer to the State Highway Department \$148.72 to improve shoulders along the Primary Highway within the Town limits of Rosalie, as requested by the Street Committee be accepted. Carried unanimously.

The considering of fire siren bids was postponed until the next meeting.

The Mayor appointed Councilmen Swedin, Brown and Blackman to canvas the ballots of the Town election held on Dec. 7, 1937, to elect three councilmen for a term of two years each, one councilman for a term of one year and a treasurer for a term of one year, and reported as follows:- Councilmen for two years - R. E. Brown 30, Elmer Swedin 30 & Geo. Blackman 29.5. Councilman one year - L. B. Martin 31. Treasurer one year - J. A. Patton 31. - B. E. Brown, Elmer Swedin and Geo. Blackman for a term of two years, L. B. Martin <sup>Councilman</sup> for term one year and J. A. Patton, treasurer for term of one year, being the unanimous choice of all voters cast, were declared elected their respective offices by the Mayor.
