Big Sky will start camera work and jetting of the sewer system this coming Wednesday. Robert Ward inquired about GIS system, Mayor will speak to JUB. Matt Floyd stated there's a leaky fire hydrant at 3<sup>rd</sup> St. and Fairview.

<u>AIRPORT:</u> Mayor will speak with Al Faunce regarding the correct area to load at the airport. Gate is still not repaired, Mayor will speak with JUB.
