Equipment Storage building – Bid opening will be on 11/17/22 at 2:00pm. A contractor inquired if the town would be open to the idea of rotating the roof orientation to save money or keep orientation as planned for future add-on. Sam asked council to send any comments they have regarding the plans to him within the next couple of days.

Water Emergency Power CDBG – Environmental review has been completed, no comments received. Funds should be released by 11/21/22. Planned bid schedule (for best response) as follows: Advertise for bids 1/12/23 and 1/19/23; pre-bid meeting Thursday 1/19/23; bid opening Thursday 2/2/23 and recommendation to award to council Tuesday 2/14/23.

DOE Sewer Project – Closeout completion by end of December 2022. Record drawings finished, electronic version and hard copy pending. GIS map updated, including as-builts from 2020, 2021 & 2022. Updating Ecology Annual Report for December 2022 and other project management support for Ecology closeout reporting and documentation.
