Jay Scholz – Requested permission to hold annual car show the 2nd Saturday in June. **John Goyke moved** to grant permission for Jay Scholz to host annual car show the 2nd Saturday in June **Ryan Diamond seconded the motion**, the motion passed unanimously. Would like to install heat pump unit at Rose Garage. Unit would be on south side of building approximately 8ft above the sidewalk and hang over approximately 3ft of the sidewalk.
