AIRPORT: Airport board located FAA approved fuel system (not sure if cardlock system is included) for \$23,500 delivered. Discussed type/amount of fuel, cardlock system, ability to sell old tank and security issues. Ryan Diamond will look into cardlock system. **John Goyke moved to approve \$24,000.00 for fuel tank at airport using only airport funding** **Judith Littleton seconded the motion**, the motion passed unanimously.

City Hall – Mayor has contacted 5 companies for estimates. Have received 3 estimates so far.

Park/Pool – Will be mowed but not watered this week. Discussed need for Park Board to have meeting to set levy for November 2025 ballot. Discussed Park Board issues. Will contact Park Board members to help facilitate meeting for levy. Will place notice on reader board and Facebook regarding Park Board positions that are still open for election.


