Lift station deemed not worth fixing. Eric Eilertson requested: A more detailed breakdown of RV park revenue and expenses. A list of individuals who paid to stay at the RV park to assess demographics.

**Community Center:** Council requested a community poll (via Facebook, newsletter, and water bill) to gauge public opinion on spending \$5,000 per year to keep the Community Building operational.

- Interest expressed in pursuing grants for Town Hall windows.


**Eric Eilertson moved** to adjourn. **Ryan Diamond seconded** the motion, and it passed unanimously.
