**Regular Meeting Minutes**

**Approval of Minutes, Claims, and Payroll:**

**Ryan Diamond moved** to approve Dec 9<sup>th</sup>, 2025, meeting minutes and transactions #1693 totaling \$5,314.50 and transactions #1739-#1881 totaling \$73,124.34 and transactions #2-#70 totaling \$7,315.31. **Judith Littleton seconded** the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

**Streets-** The snowplow blade is in need of servicing. Goyke or the Public Works Department will obtain cost estimates. The Mayor also requested that the town explore the potential purchase of a street sweeper.

**Rv Park-** The Town will move forward with the application process for the 0.09 funds

**Website-** Updated.




