Regular Meeting Minutes

Call to Order: 7:31pm

Approval of Minutes, Claims, and Payroll:

Val Bryan moved to approve Feb 10th, 2026, meeting minutes and transactions #242-#327 totaling \$22,995.80. **Ryan Diamond seconded** the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

RV Park: Port of whitman grant is a reimbursement grant and project will start once weather gets better.

Park & Pool: No word back from the school about paying the ball field water bill. The park board did pass the levy, but the prior year's levy didn't pass and money was still taken out and used. Because of that, the park board still owes the county \$30,000, leaving no money to run and operate the pool. If the park board disbands, the county would take all assets, which could include the park itself. Further title searches are being done to determine who owns the park, lagoons, and mini park.

City Hall: bids are still on radar


Website: Not updated


