Regular Meeting Minutes

Call to Order: 7:30pm

Roll Call: Mayor John Goyke, Judith Littleton, Val Bryan, Ryan Diamond, Eric Eilertson

Absence excused: John Berggren

Approval of Minutes, Claims, and Payroll:

Eric Eilertson moved to approve Feb 24th, 2026, meeting minutes and transactions #343-#358 totaling \$17,533.90. **Val Bryan** seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Guests: Deputy Clerk talked about some future conferences she plans to attend that could help the town with future funding opportunities.

Sam and Derick from JUB discussed the USDOT PHMSA TAG Grant, 2026 scrub seal improvements, a partial planning update, and airport funding eligibility. They also talked about updating the six-year street plan and setting up a workshop with council members so everyone can get their ideas out and make sure communication is all on the same page. The goal is to figure out what's at the top of everyone's list so we can work together with JUB. That meeting will most likely happen in April.

Judith Littleton motions to approve and sign agreement Spokane interlocal agreement No. RP-26-00170 **Eric Eilertson** seconded and motion passes unanimously.

Greg Herr was a guest as well and asked for an update on the Mouse House that he lives near. It was also mentioned that the town has been placing ads in newspapers and is actively looking for a new town lawyer to help with the process.

Eric Eilertson moved to approve Spokane County Interlocal Agreement and **Judith Littleton** seconds and motion passed unanimously.

Streets: PWD are cleaning and clearing storm drains.

Water: None

Sewer: None

Airport: Ryan stated he was having a meeting to set up a new hangar and sign the lease agreement.

Code Enforcement: Still working on getting a new lawyer. The current code enforcer is recovering from some medical issues.

Library: went over current grant funding

RV Park: Went over the RV park rules and decided on a \$40 daily prepaid rate. The park will be open from March 1 to October 31. The maximum stay will be 10 nights within a 30-day period, and guests must wait 30 days after their last night before they can stay again.

Park & Pool: Waiting on titles.

Community Center & City Hall: Decided to wait on bids for the library for now and instead call someone out to look at doing all the roofing.

Website: Updated

Miscellaneous: IT needs upgrading and new laptops; pricing will be brought to the next meeting.
The Avista franchise agreement was handed over to the council for review ahead of the next meeting.

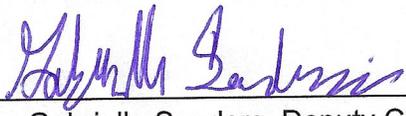
Council comments:
