MINUTES

Call to Order: 7:30 pm

Roll Call: Mayor John Goyke, Eric Eilertson, John Berggren, Valerie Bryan, Judith Littleton, Ryan Diamond excused.

Approval of Minutes, Claims, and Payroll: It was moved by **Eric Eilertson** and seconded by **John Berggren** to approve the minutes of the June 9, 2026 meeting minutes and transactions 838 through 933 totaling \$19,454.74. The motion passed unanimously..

It was moved by **Eric Eilertson** and **seconded by** Valerie Bryan to approve the minutes of the June 11, 2026 special meeting. The motion passed unanimously.

Six Year Street Plan and JUB funding: It was moved by **John Berggren** and seconded by **Valerie Bryan** to approve the Six Year Street Plan as presented. The motion passed unanimously.

Fireworks Discussion: There was discussion about fire danger from the extremely dry conditions. It was decided by consensus that the "Town of Rosalia wishes you a happy 4th. Be Safe." Would be posted on the town reader board.

Miscellaneous topics: Texaco flag pole is down for repair. Library grant is being managed by Whitman County Library. RV park saw limited use over Battle Days.

Park and Pool: Mayor Goyke presented a task list for town maintenance employees so facilities are always ready for community use. The pool is scheduled to open July 4th if the repairs are completed. Whitman County Commissioners approved a loan to the Park and Recreation District for pool operation based on the Interlocal agreement between the town and the park district.

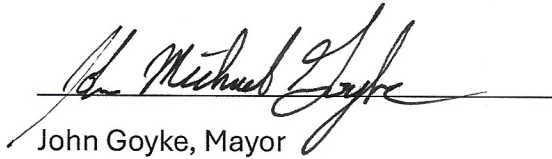
Interlocal Agreement between Town and Whitman County: It was moved by **Eric Eilertson** and seconded by **John Berggren** to approve the Whitman County Waste Management plan with option c. The motion carried unanimously.

Financial Reports: Financial Reports and bank statement were presented for Council review. This will be a continuing effort to be certain that the Council is completely aware of the current financial status of the town.

TexMyGov: It was moved by **Valerie Bryan** and seconded by **John Berggren** to reject membership in TexMyGov program. The motion passed unanimously.

Street Levy: Deadline for setting the street levy for the fall is approaching. Following discussion, it was moved by **Judith Littleton** and seconded by **Valerie Bryan** to set the levy amount at \$50,000. The motion passed on a three to one vote. The resolution for the ballot measure will be presented at the next meeting.

Adjournment: It was moved by **Valerie Bryan** and seconded by **John Berggren** to adjourn the meeting at 8:40 pm. The motion passed unanimously.
