Regular Meeting Minutes

Call to Order: 7:32pm

Roll Call: Mayor John Goyke, Judith Littleton, Ryan Diamond, Eric Eilertson, Valerie Bryan

Approval of Minutes, Claims, and Payroll:

Eric Eilertson moved to approve June 23rd, 2026, meeting minutes and transactions #920-#1045 totaling \$55,822.71. **Valerie Bryan seconded** the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Guests: Sam from JUB, Pat Voge, & Jacob Billington

Sam from JUB discussed partial planning update (commerce 26-63114-102) all year 1 deliverables have been submitted, commerce plans to start Issing Year 2 draft contracts in late July 2026 and a rough Year 2 workplan update.

Judith Littleton motioned to approve the mayor to sign PWB Funding Application 523-727 and let Sam from JUB apply for the funding and **Eric Eilertson seconded** the motion **passed unanimously**.

Streets: The street project will be finishing up the last week in July and concerned farmers have been notified and asked to plan trucks around it, will take three days to complete. Discussion about street levy and potentially purchasing street sweeper, painting sidewalks and snowplows was discussed.

Judith Littleton motioned to approve Resolution 26-01 **Valerie Bryan** seconded the motion went to vote and wasn't unanimous but passed by voice vote.

Water: Low pressure was reported during 4th of July, and a leak was found near 804 S Whitman Ave and 115 W Eighth Street which PWD will fix and will let residents know when shut off is happening as well as when they fix the well house check value. And a meter was added to the fire station some company was taking water without talking to town or fire station but now that's metered.

Sewer: Eric Eilterson motioned to have Zero Emissions to come to next council meeting to show and discuss the solar panels. Ryan diamond Seconded. Vote was 2/2, chair votes tie breaker, yes. **Motion passes.**

Code Enforcement: Last update from lawyer was that she is working on updating ordinances and Mayor will call her this week.

Library: Grant is coming along and library will be closed first week of August for normal summer break.

RV Park: Open. Updated from Jacob Billington isolation values were installed, electric panels were fixed and put on steel posts, waiting on gravel and asphalt and once that's delivered a roller will be rented to compact it and the fence materials will be put in and all signs saying RV park is closed will be taken down.

Park & Pool: Weeded, waiting for interlocal agreement with Park and Rec, we have two meters water now, but the Avista meter is all one. Discussed title searches. Park renovations will happen bathroom will close for 2 weeks while pwd installs new walls.

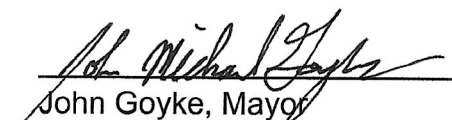
Website & Reader: Updated

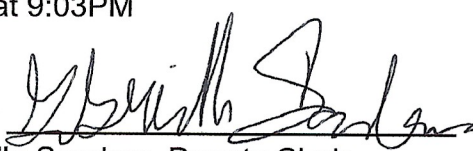
Miscellaneous: Consensus with council was to keep mosquito spraying once a week.
