Regular Meeting Minutes

Call to Order: 7:30pm

Approval of Minutes, Claims, and Payroll:

Eric Eilertson moved to approve August 25th, 2026, meeting minutes and transactions #1247-#1284 totaling \$17,946.05. **Judith Littleton seconded** the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Guests: Pat Voge present.

Hannah Kimball Town Attorney: Presented new Ordinance 614 with updated language and corrected penalties. Changes discussed from previous draft.

Eric Eilertson motioned to approve Ordinance 614 as presented **John Berggren** seconded and the motion passed unanimously.

Street: The mayor will contact tree removal contractors and obtain at least two quotes for removal of trees located within the Town right-of-way. One tree has branches affecting homeowners' property and insurance concerns, while another tree is obstructing the lane and creating a potential safety hazard for drivers and pedestrians. Upon receipt of the quotes, the mayor will proceed with the necessary tree removal.

Sewer: Resolution #26-02 passed earlier in the year just passed around for signatures from council to be published.

Water: Public Works staff discussed changing the water leak material for the Railroad leak project.

Airport: Discussed the pilot's lounge.

Code Enforcement: Discussed previously addressed code enforcement matters.

Library: Bids are being prepared and will be going out.

RV Park: No estimated completion date currently. The RV Park is currently being occupied.

Park/Pool: Requested Town attorney to help with getting park titles.

Community Center: Discussed the improvements that need to be completed, the possibility of selling the property for fair market value, and the potential outcomes if a buyer were to purchase it.

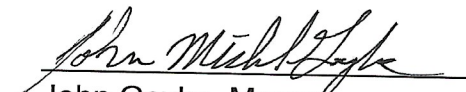
