Regular Meeting Minutes

Call to Order: 7:30pm

Roll Call: Mayor John Goyke, Judith Littleton, Ryan Diamond, Eric Eilertson, Valerie Bryan, John Berggren

Approval of Minutes, Claims, and Payroll:

Eric Eilertson moved to approve July 14th, 2026, meeting minutes and transactions #1075-#1111 totaling \$25,963.65. **Judith Littleton seconded** the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Greg Herr shared photos of the neighboring property and asked what progress has been made toward addressing the condition of the property before winter arrives and before another potential mouse infestation occurs. The photos and related information will be shared with the Town Attorney for review. The Mayor shared that the Town Attorney is currently working on updating the Town's ordinances, so they are current and enforceable if legal action becomes necessary.

Brian Burrow provided information regarding zero-emission solar panels, including an overview of how the technology works, estimated costs, background information, and potential benefits.

John Berggren made a motion to allow Brian Burrow to continue with the preliminary application process. **Ryan Diamond seconded** the motion. The motion passed.

Streets: Potholes marked and TIB project delayed a couple days this week.

Water: Water service was temporarily shut off from 1st Street and along North Whitman Avenue, from Harvest Church to the bus garage, to allow the Public Works Department to repair a valve in the well house

Code Enforcement: As far as employees go for code enforcement as soon as we update code enforcement, we will not need to have an employee in that position. When the ordinance is updated, we won't actually need a code enforcement officer paid to enforce the ordinances.

Council comments: None

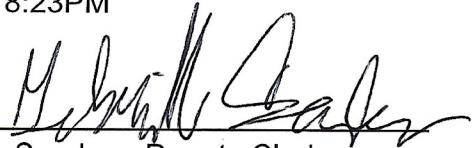
Judith Littleton moved to adjourn. **Eric Eilterson seconded** the motion, and it passed unanimously.
